Visits may be booked in the following manner

By telephone (07) 3212 0472, or by filling in a pre-booking form, prior to your visit, in person over the counter. Facsimiles will not be accepted.

Only the names submitted will be permitted access to the centre on the visiting day.
A maximum of three (3) adults and a reasonable number of children may visit each prisoner.

All money, property and bookings must be submitted prior to commencement of the visit.

Note:

The Corrective Services Act 2000 Section 102 “ Offences by persons other than prisoners” states:

“A person who fraudulently obtains authorisation to enter a prison whether for himself or another, commits an offence against this Act and may be liable to a fine of 100 penalty units or to imprisonment for 2 years or both of these penalties”.

BE AWARE

That anyone giving false information or incorrect particulars may be liable for prosecution under the above Act. **Your visit may be monitored and recorded in the interest of the security and good order of the centre.**

This includes add-ons and re-bookings.

Conditions of entry and identification required

ID for children :

Student ID card
Current passport or

Any two of the following:

Current Medicare card
Current Gov. entitlement card
Birth certificate
Current student statement of enrolment
Education report less than six months old.

Adults

Current drivers licence with current address or passport or
Three (3) of the following:

- Bank keycard or credit card
- Healthcare card
- Pension card
- Birth certificate
- Medicare card
- Statutory declaration
- Photo ID with a signature

If unable to produce a current drivers licence, passport or three forms of identification on each visit entry into this centre will not be granted.

If you are currently on bail or parole, your papers must be presented upon arrival each visit.

Minors are visitors under the age of 18 years and will not be permitted entry without a parent or letter from the General Manager.

If you have received a conviction by a court you must declare this irrespective of the penalty imposed. Failure to declare convictions may result in suspension of visits.

Dress standards

Conservative dress is to be worn at all times. Thongs, open shoes or transparent / revealing clothing will not be permitted to be worn at visits.

Prams/strollers will not be permitted in the visits area.

AUTHORISED ITEMS ALLOWED IN THE CENTRE

A maximum of twenty (\$20) dollars worth of coins can be taken into the visits area for the use of the vending machines.

(Change is not given at the front counter)

Two baby bottles and one shawl.

UNAUTHORISED ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN THE CENTRE

All detachable items eg. jewellery, tobacco, hair ties/clips, belts, car keys, handbags, paperwork, etc. are to be placed in the locker provided.

NO ITEMS ARE TO BE TAKEN INTO THE CENTRE WITHOUT AUTHORISATION.

Property information

Items of property may be passed out to visitors via the front desk. An approved prisoner request is required prior to handing out property.

Enquires at the front desk

Prior to your visit

Please inform the front desk staff if you are collecting property before your visit.

Property may be delivered 0800-1630hrs (Mon-Fri) and 0800-1600 (Sat-Sun).

Property may be picked up between 1300hrs and 1600hrs (Mon-Fri).

Items accepted without a prisoner request are:

- Cash for prisoners trust account
- New solid plastic hair brush (in packet)
- New underwear (in packet) (No Boxer Shorts)
- New socks
- New singlets (blue no logos and in packets 4 max)
- Photographs – Not laminated or Polaroid types.
- Court clothes (one complete set, 1 suit, 1 shoes, 1 belt, and tie)

No other items will be accepted.

Days which shall be observed as prison holidays are:

New Years Day
Good Friday
Queens Birthday
Australia Day
Christmas Day
Anzac Day

Visiting will not occur on these days.
